I would like to see the nation develop a national water grid including turning back water from the northern rivers to the Murray Darling basin and/ or a modification of the Bradfield plan.

The cost was estimated in a media release at about \$10 billion.

That is about the cost of 5 Caulfield Racecourses. The estimated cost of say \$10 billion seems very small when compared with the benefits to billions of dollars of existing investment.
