I believe that Landcare was over-funded, and poorly managed

because

- 1. funds were often squandered on small projects without a larger strategic framework., that many lifestyle (small landholdings) soaked up significant funding on insignificant works.
- 2. That is was too easy to access funds.
- 3. That too much money was spent on administering projects.
- 4. That there were legal loopholes that allowed farmers to take the money, but not necessarily honour the spirit of the agreement.

For instance: A local farm "Vaucluse" Conara accessed significant funding for salinity works including volunteers working weeks.

- a few years later the livestock were allowed to destroy the project during a drought.
- 5. That Landcare and NHT became "meal tickets " for professionals all over Australia with dubious longterm benefits.
- 6. That some people that would struggle to gain employment elsewhere, were happily employed by Landcare etc.

A thorough review of the effectiveness of this funding is long overdue.
