Many students and potential students will be disadvantaged by the proposed changes to the point in which they may not be able to afford any more education. The 30 hours over 18 months required to achieve independence under the changes does not correspond with the 12 month course defer maximum of institutes. gifted and highly academic students will be denied government assisted education due to parents income.
