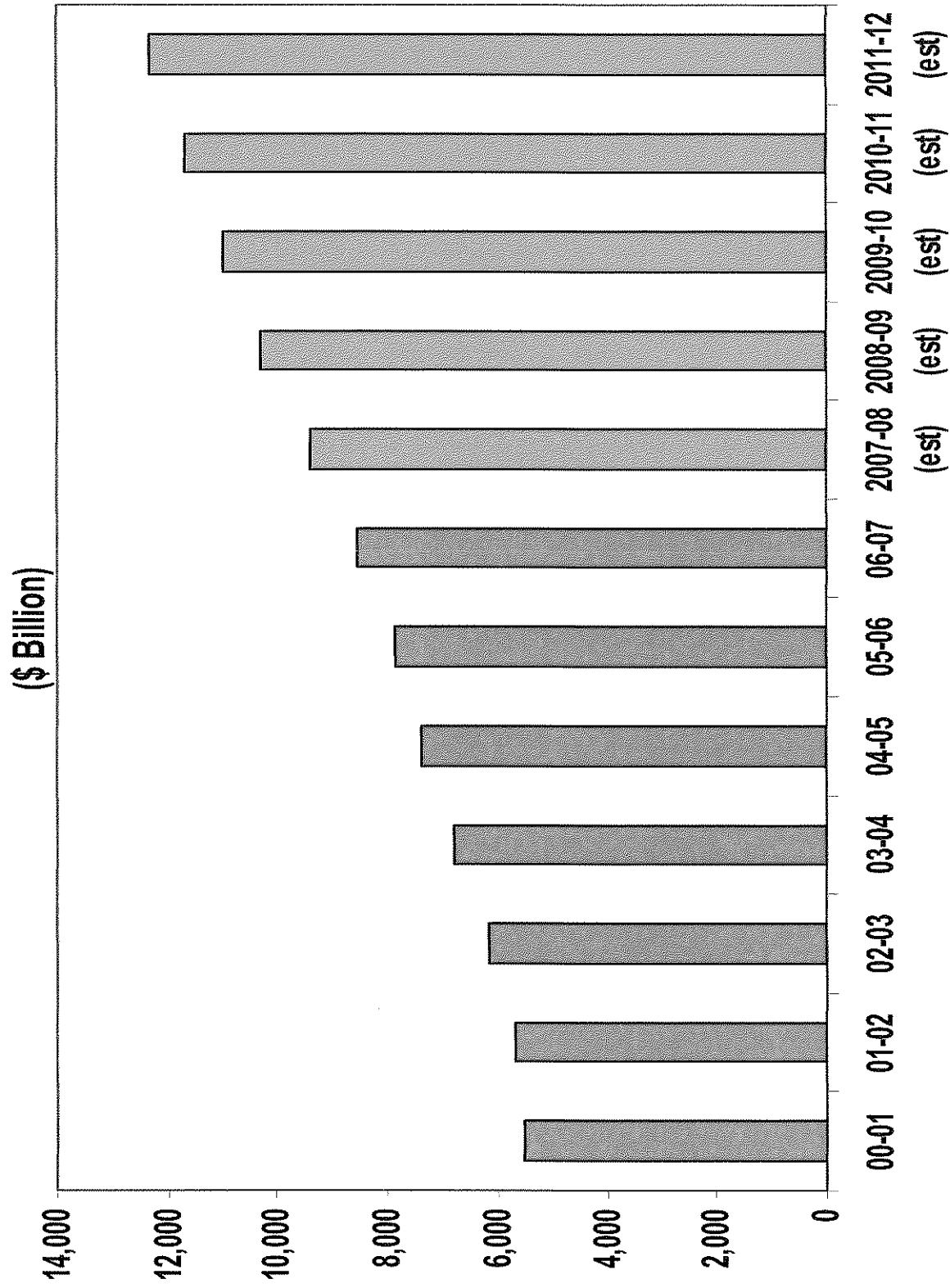

Graph 1: GST - UNPRECEDENTED REVENUE STREAM



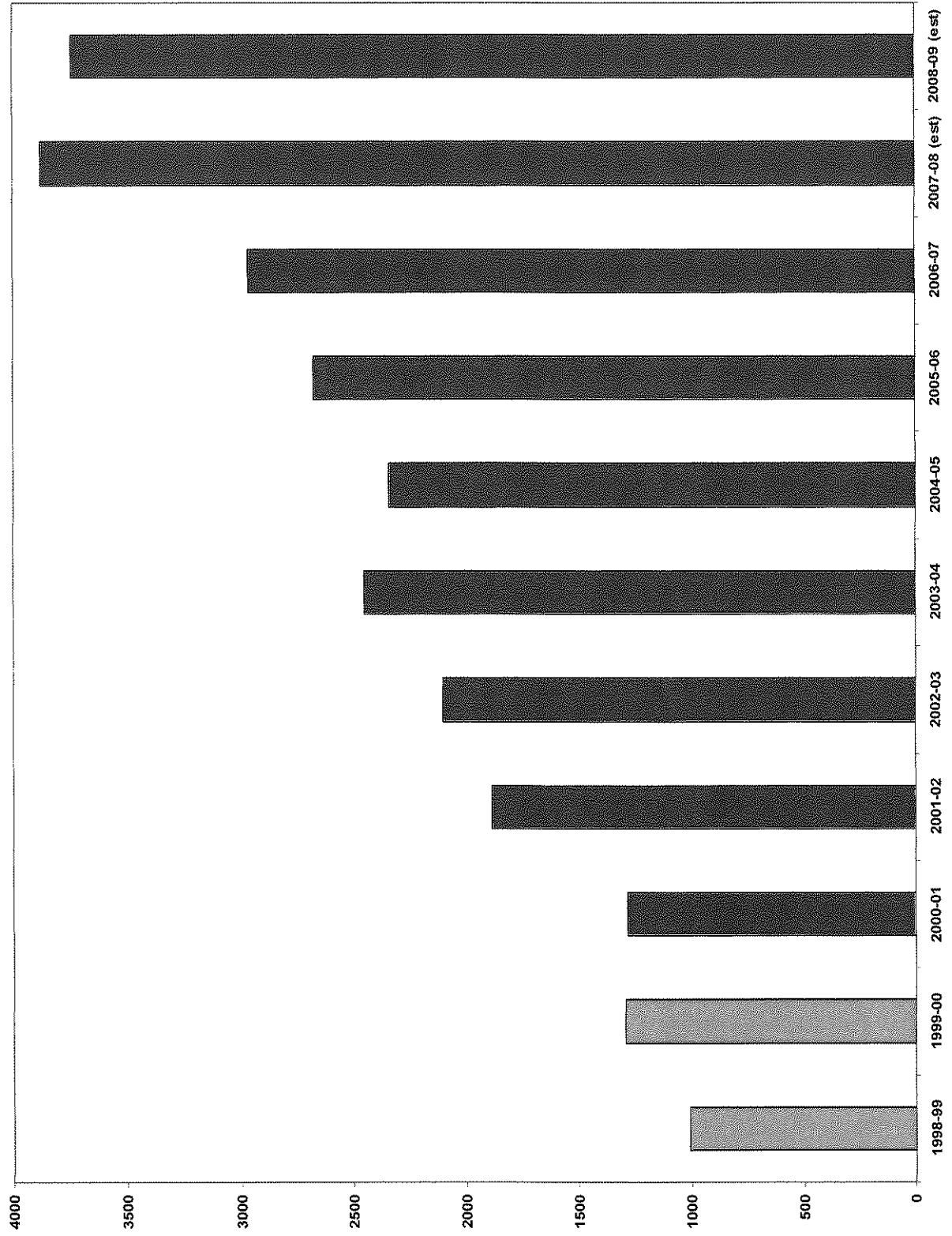

(\$ Million)



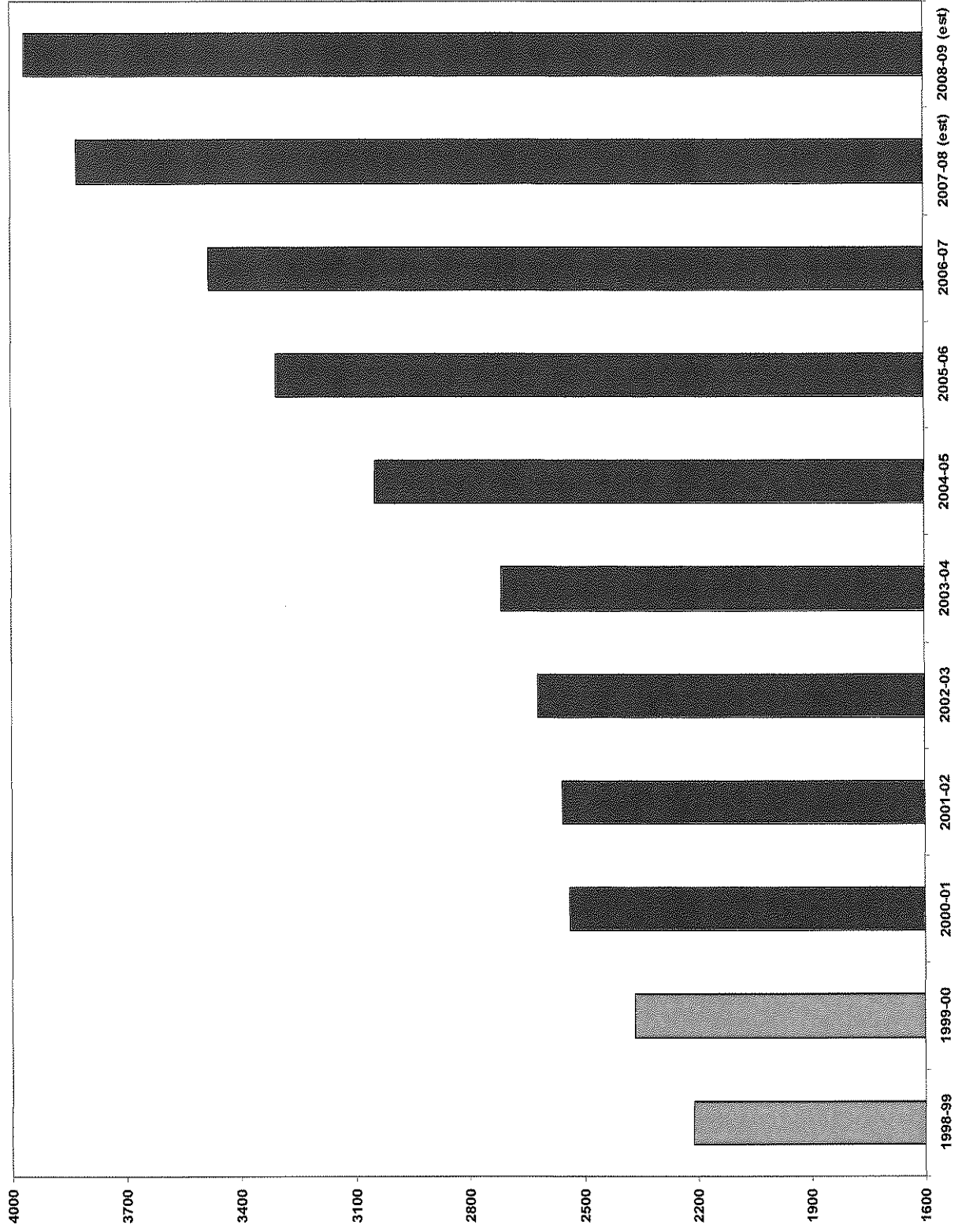

(\$ Million)**



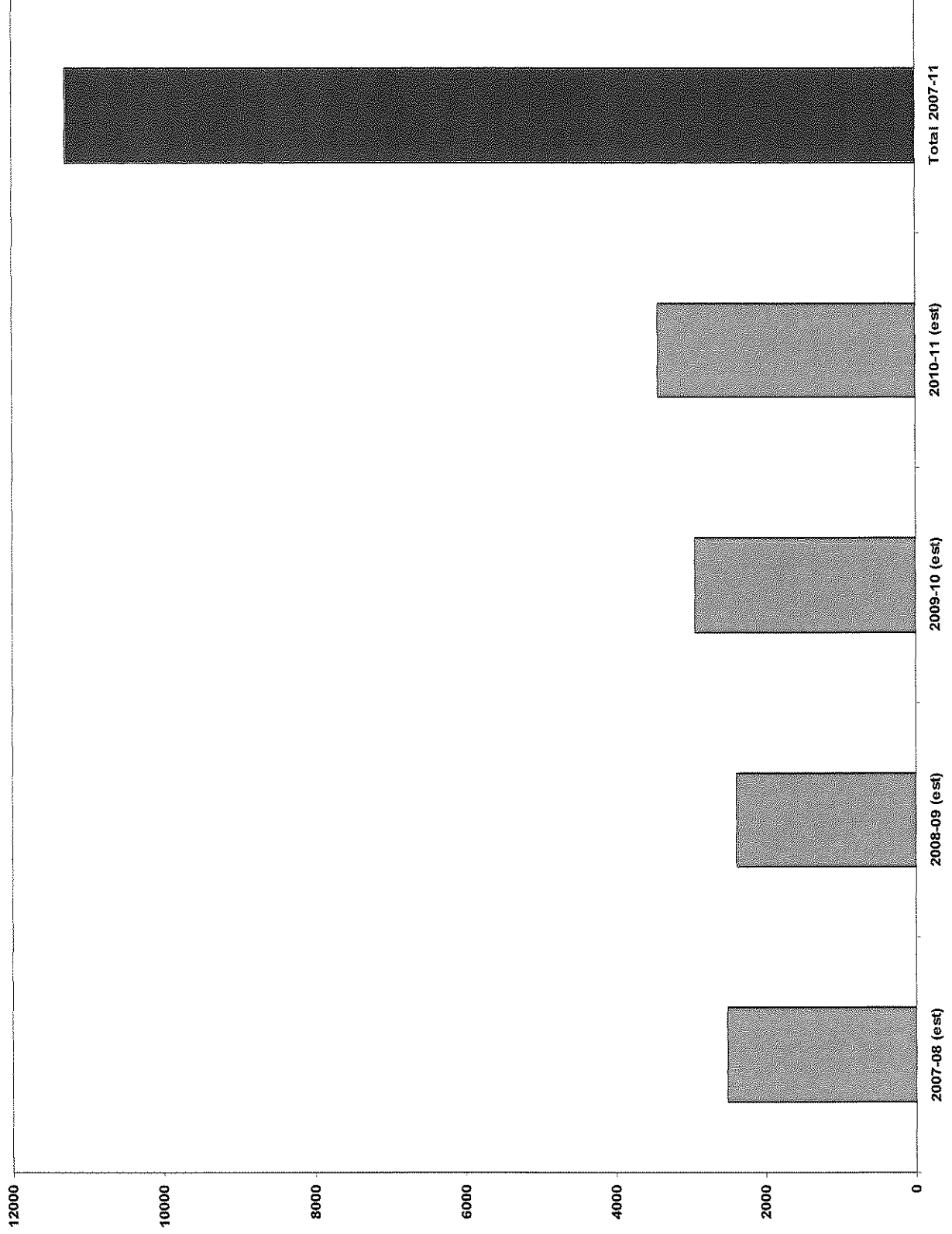

(\$ Million)**



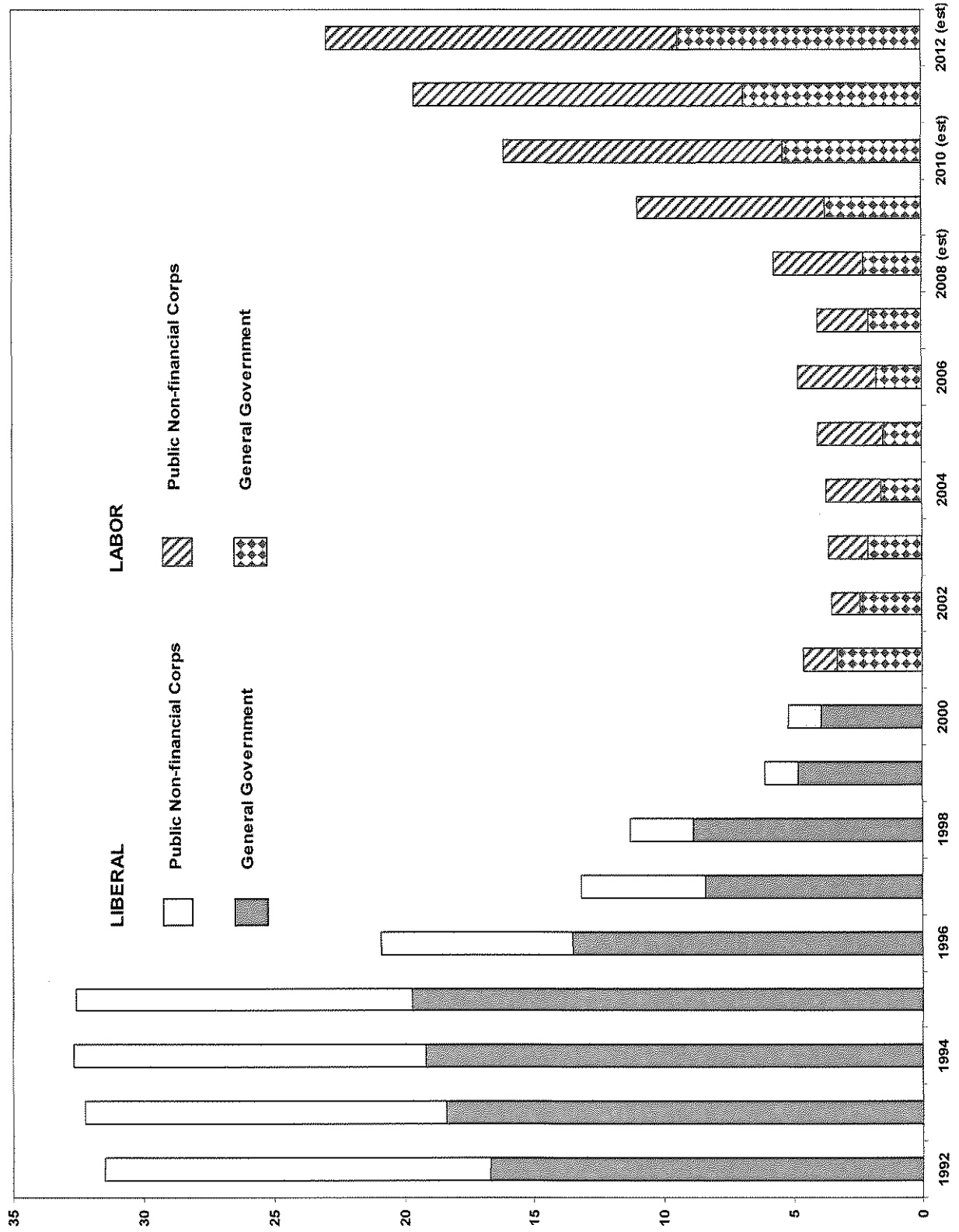

(Estimated Increase in Budget Revenues Since 2007 - 08 Budget; \$ Million)



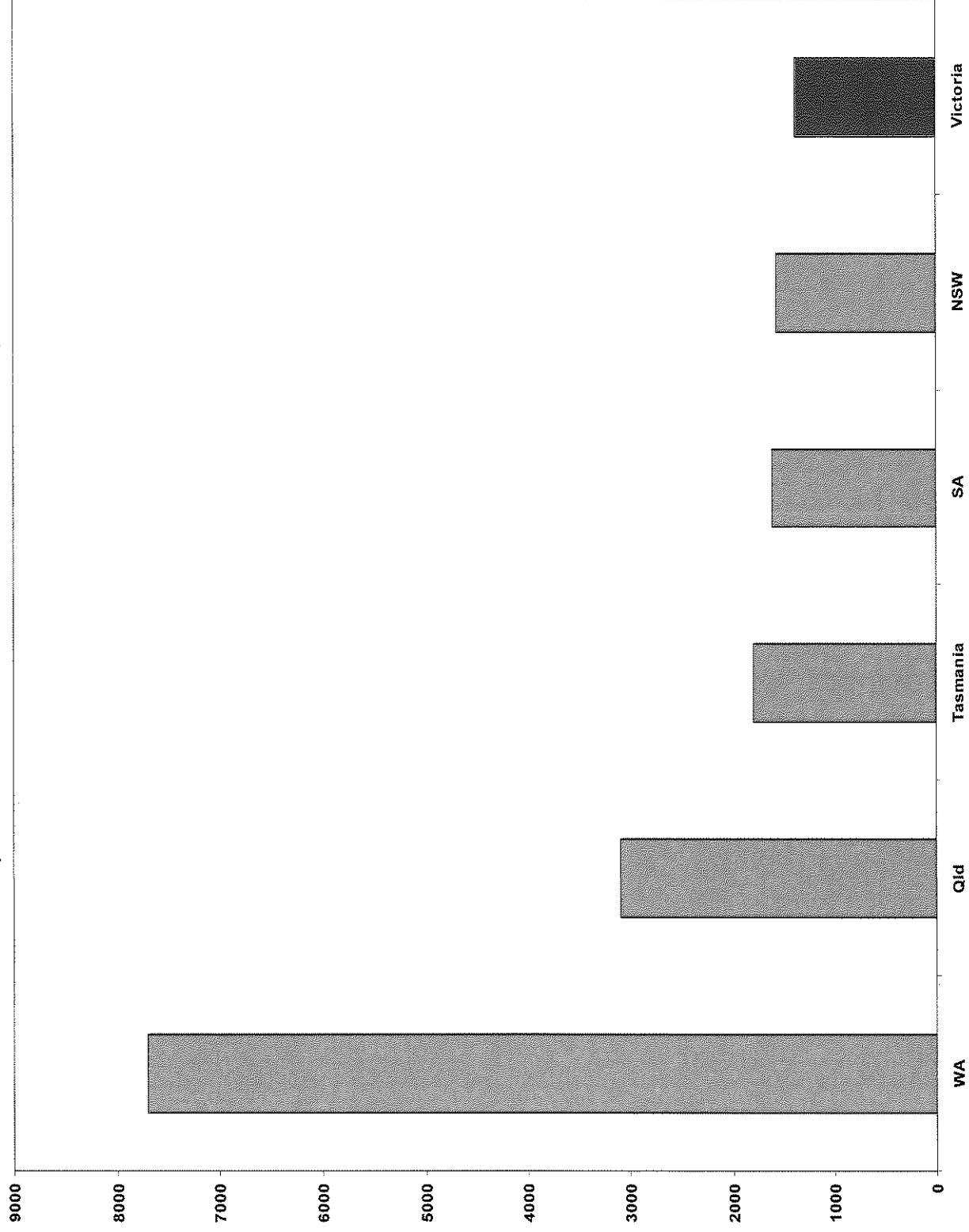

(Overall Net State Debt - \$ Billion)



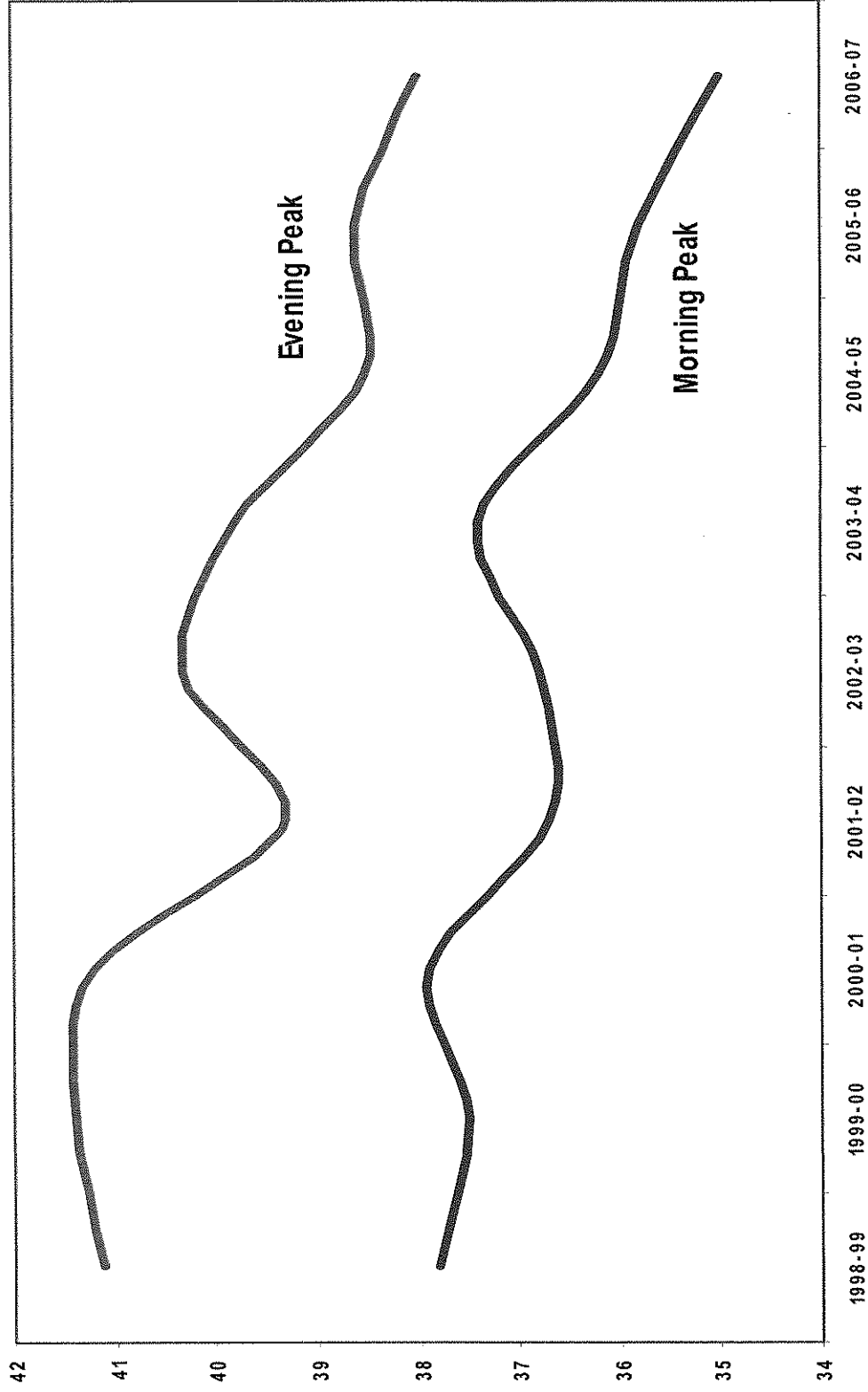

(2006-07, \$ Construction Work Done Per Head)



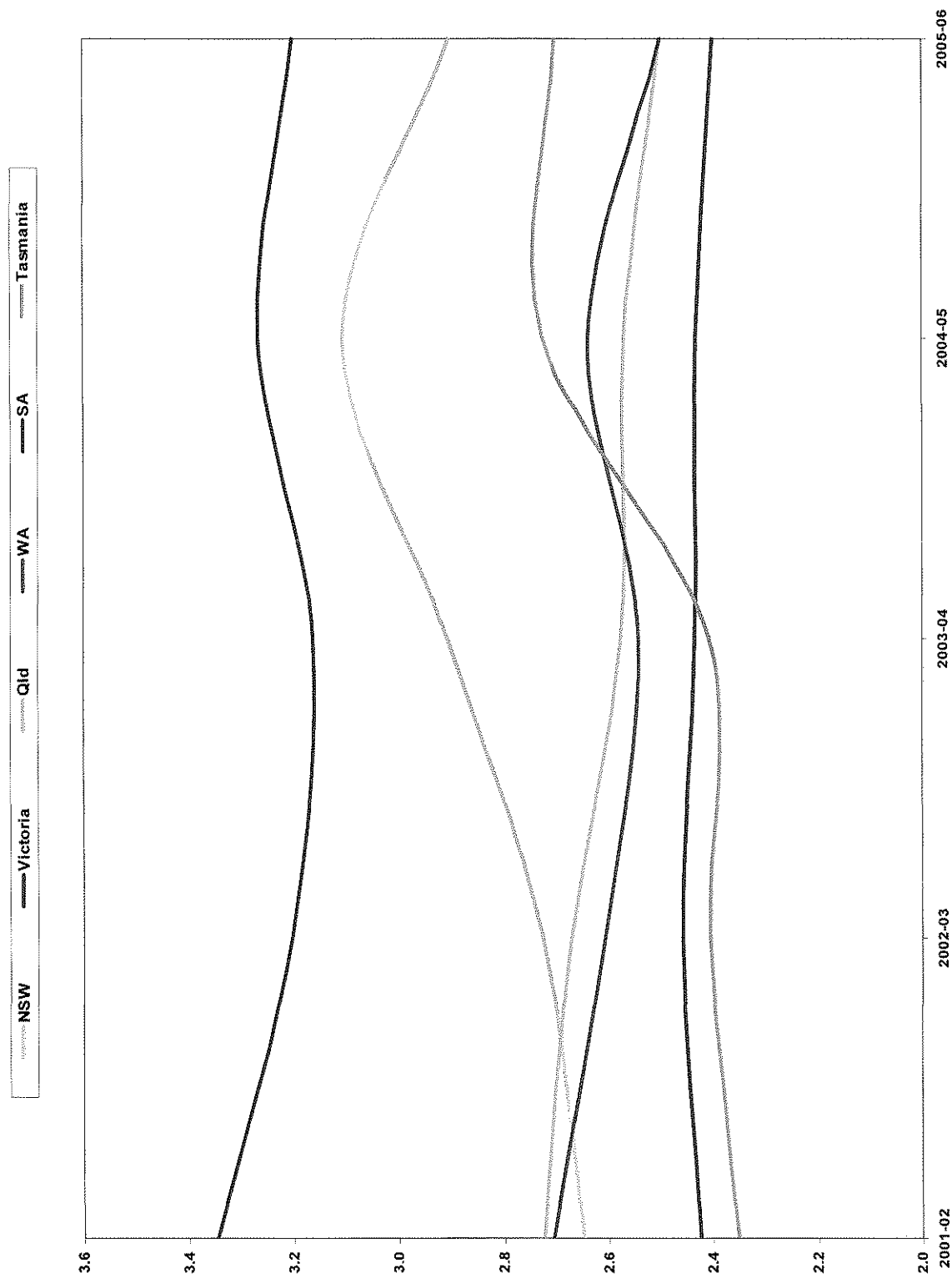

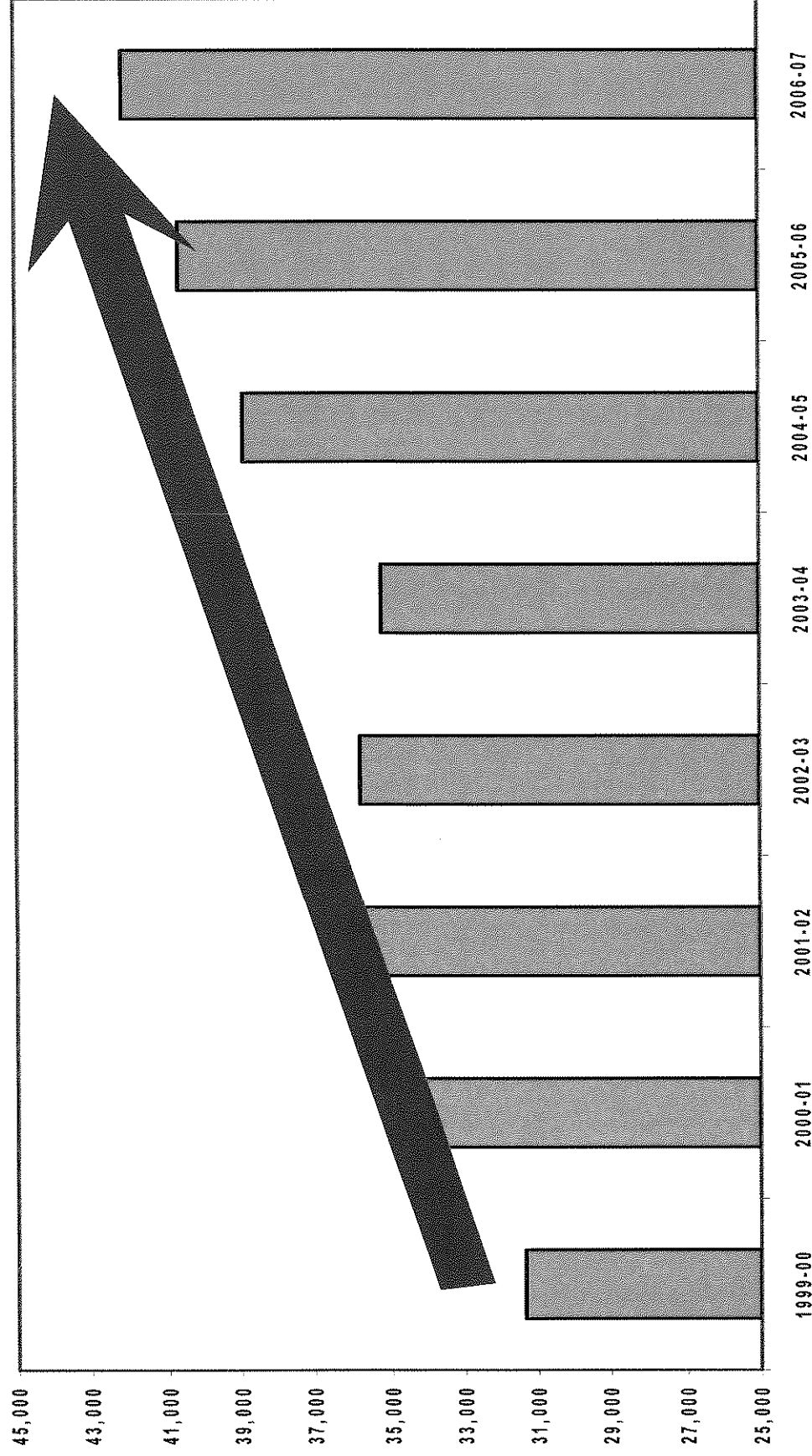
GRAPH # 9: FEWEST HOSPITAL BEDS IN AUSTRALIA

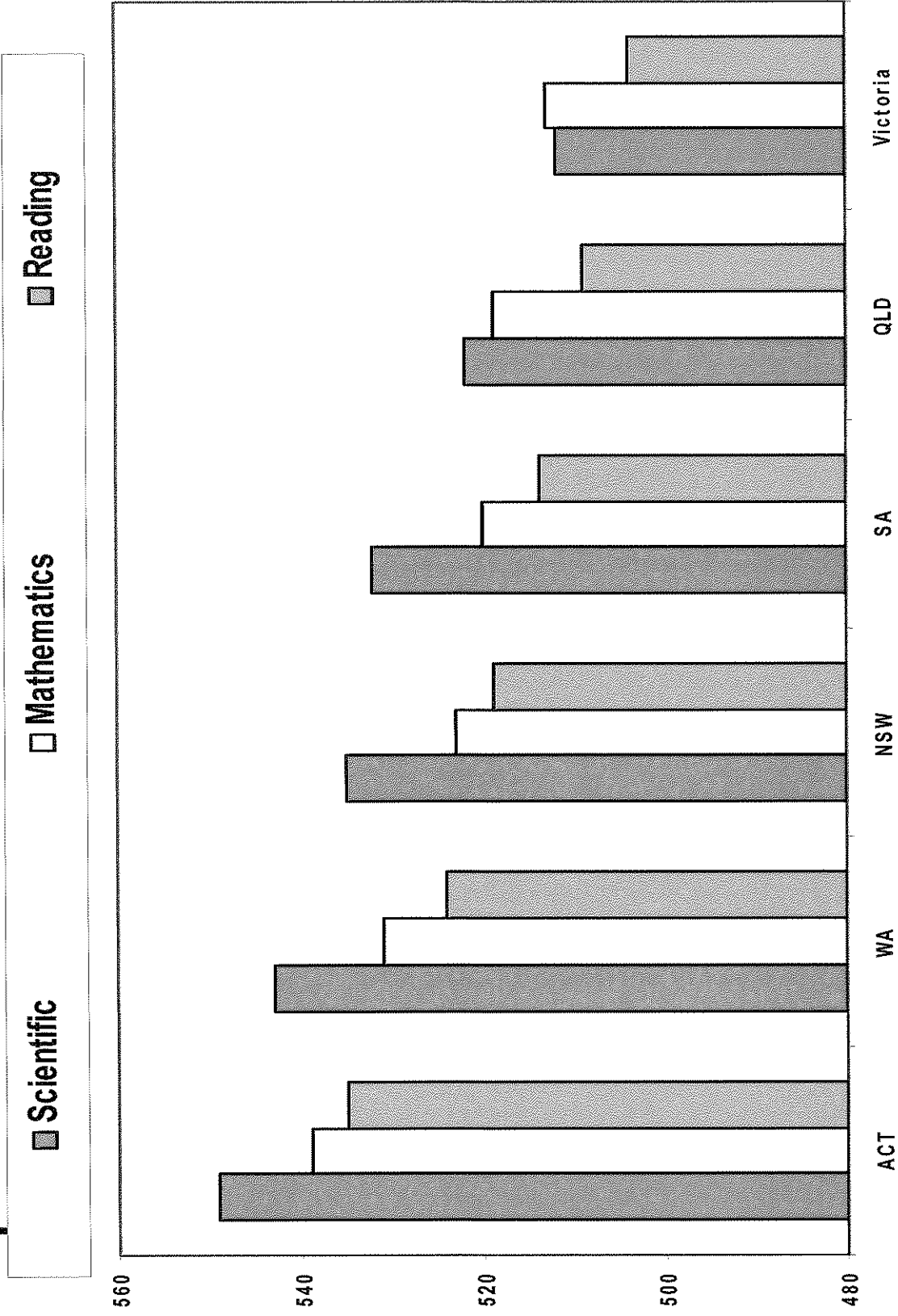
GRAPH # 10 : OUR STREETS ARE MORE DANGEROUS

(Violent Incidents in Victoria)



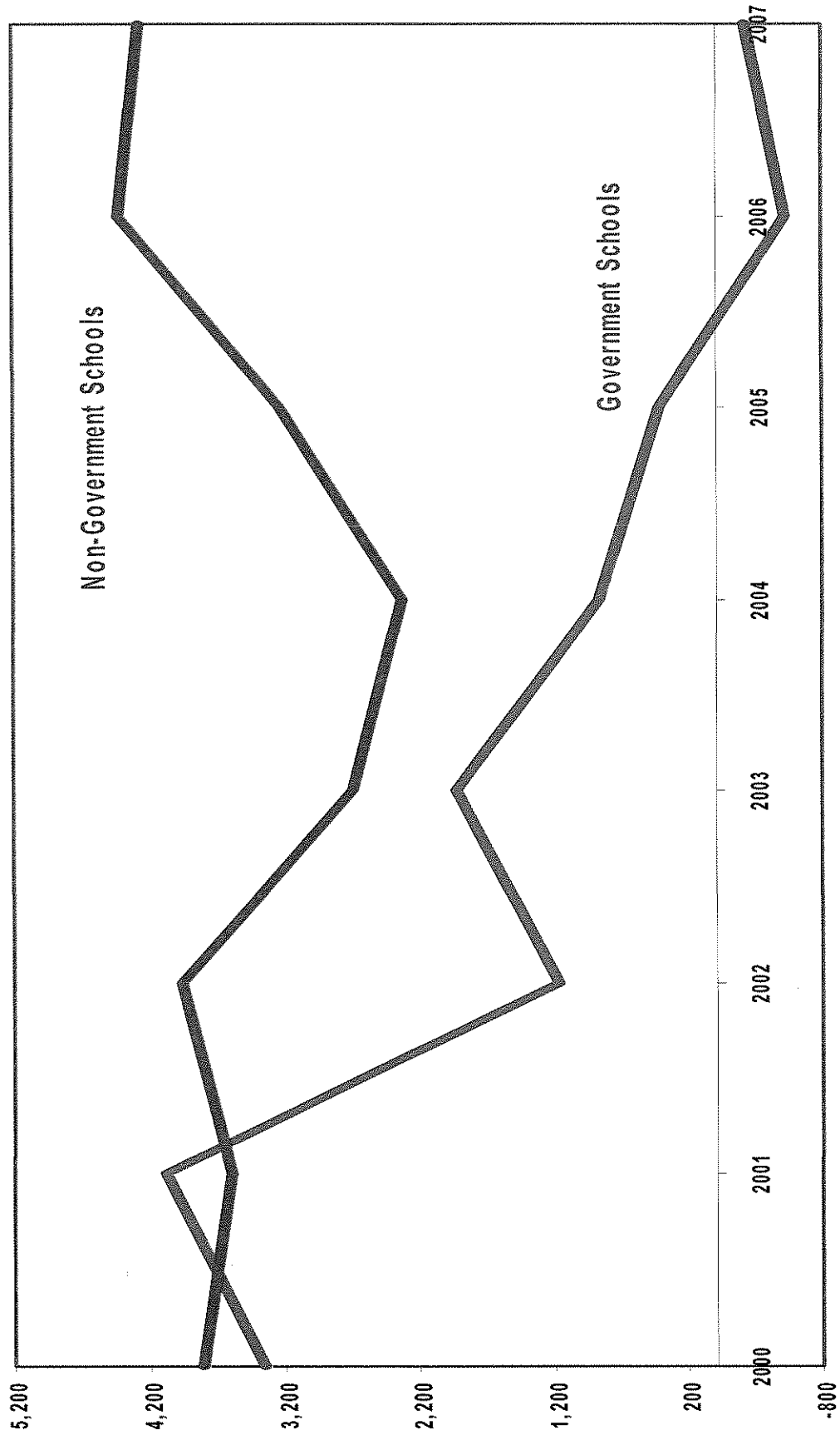

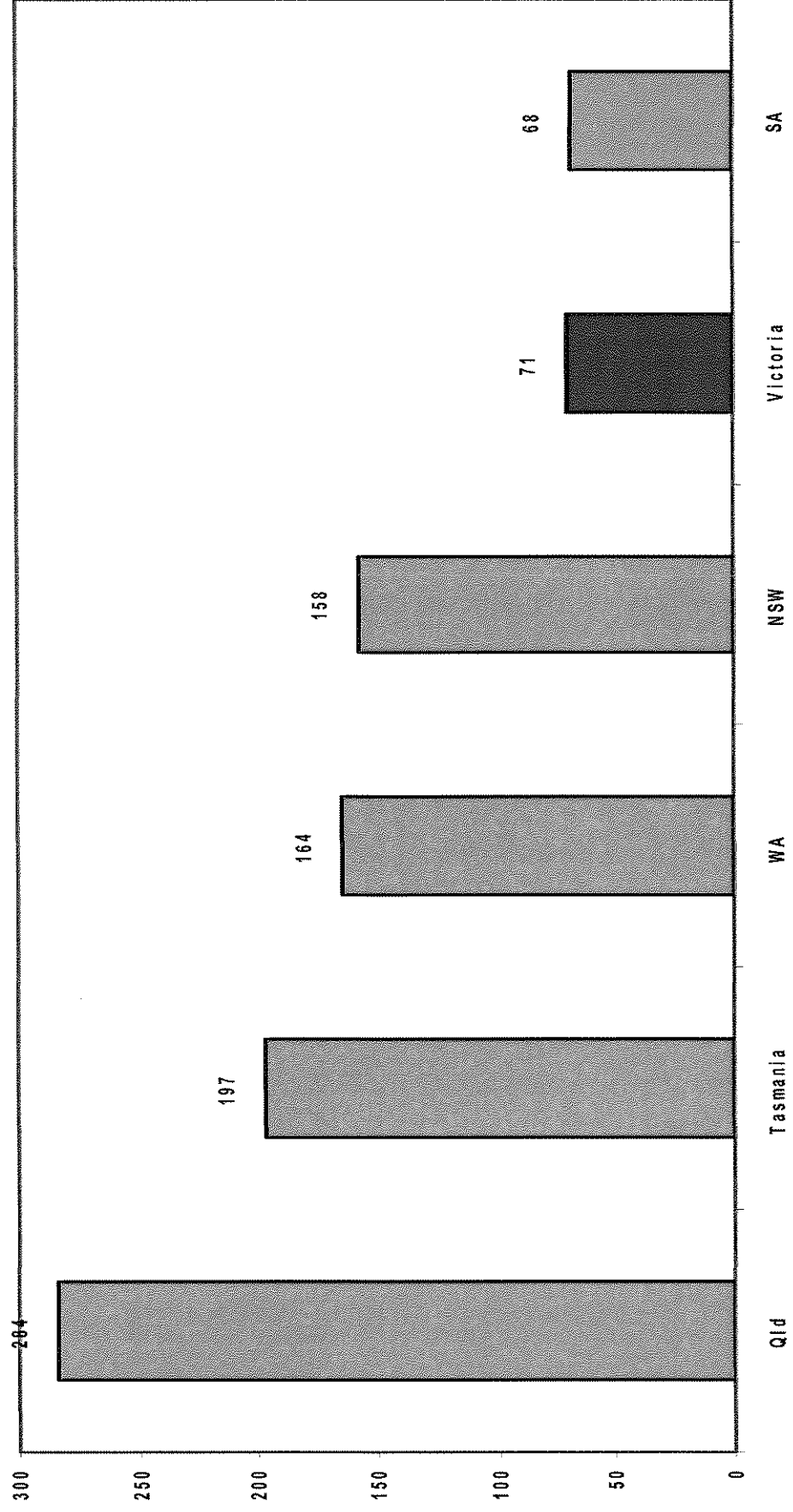
GRAPH # 12 : PARENTS VOTING WITH THEIR FEET

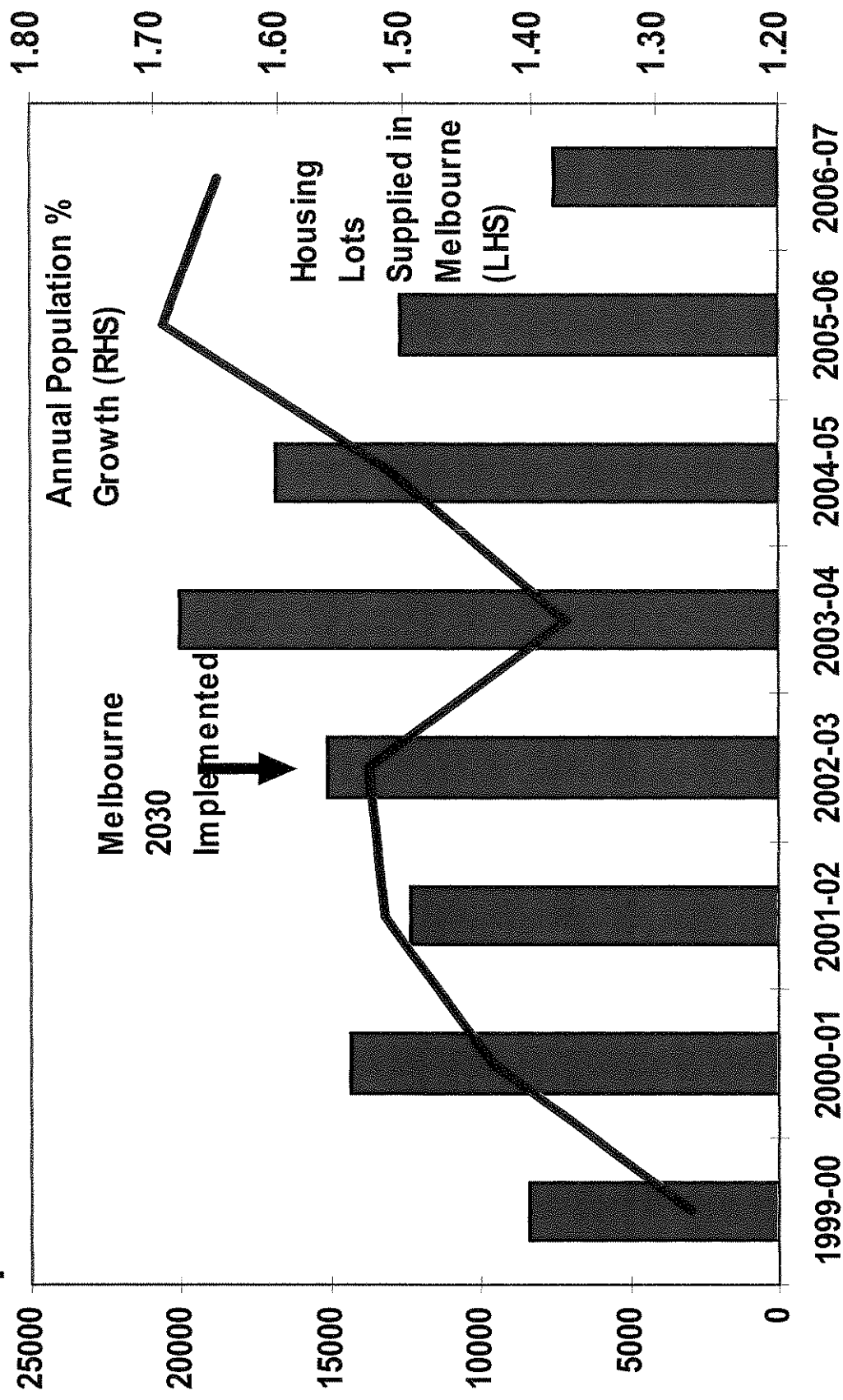
GRAPH # 13: VICTORIA UNDER-INVESTS IN WATER
