I wish to submit the details of what I feel to be inappropriate administration of funds by a solicitor as follows: -

My late husband and I had invested our retirement funds with solicitors Piggott, Wood and Baker (PWB) of 199 Macquarie Street, Hobart, Tasmania 7000.

Of this PWB loaned at their discretion 3 amounts as follows: -

\$26,000.00 to Everworth (Tas) Pty Ltd

\$20,000.00 to Sunny Hill Cpountry Club

\$30,000.00 to F. & H. M. Bacic, 1 Cordelia Court, Rosetta 7010

All of the above enterprises failed.

I have recovered: - \$2,899.46 from Sunny Hill Country Club

\$14,450.00 from F & H M Bacic

Nil as yet from Everworth

I have sustained a loss of \$58,650.54 on what should have been, I feel, a safe investment with the solicitors, and at 80 years of age this is a traumatic experience for me.

I have documentary evidence to support this submission.
