<u>Defaulting Contributory Mortgages</u> <u>Principal Outstanding \$2,570,638</u> Controlling Solicitors – Piggott Wood & Baker, Hobart

My wife, Betty Margaret Clennett, had \$23,000 applied to the above mortgage, namely DP & LJ Krushka Family Trust No. 3. The Krushka's are bankrupt (September, 1999). The relevant property has been sold. My wife received \$3,334 in settlement leaving a capital loss of \$19,666. This loss represents an 85% loss of capital.

The relevant property was valued at \$4,400,000. The loan principal was \$3,006,500. It was in respect of a new hotel the Sunny Hills Country Club. In my view it was in a most unpromising locale – in Ravenswood, a Housing Commission subdivision on the outskirts of Launceston – looking out over open fields. The net proceeds on sale were \$445,861.

The matter is under litigation. A mixture of written and verbal information, available to me, strongly indicates that the majority of the lenders both as to number and as to value have not taken action. It is suggested this is because of embarrassment, lack of knowledge or age.

It has now come to my attention, the injudicious loan, was represented as worthwhile, on the major prospects of the introduction of poker machines and TAB facilities in a Housing Commission subdivision.
